## Did you know?

Effective January 1, 2022 if you qualify for short-term disability the weekly benefits are 60% of straight-time earnings subject to a maximum of \$630.

Effective January 1, 2022 if you qualify for long-term disability the monthly benefits are 50% of straight-time earnings subject to a maximum of \$2,400.

Effective January 1, 2022 Basic Life Insurance, Accidental Death and Dismemberment benefits will be \$36,500.

There are scholarships available to any eligible dependent of a retired or active Local 833 member.

These scholarships are for High School graduates or dependents that are already in college.

Also, there are seven UAW CAP scholarships available. These scholarships are open to all surrounding UAW members' eligible dependents. Six of these scholarships are for high school graduates & one is for a student already enrolled in UW Sheboygan.

**Applications are available in their high school guidance office, in plant, and at Emil Mazey Hall.**

If all requirements of the application are not met, the application will be denied.

\*The applicant must be the member's child, step-child or legal dependent in order to be eligible\*



**Did you know?**

The Election Committee is looking for members to help with Union elections. Article VII, Nominations and elections of officers and election committee. Section 7.01 Any member who is not on the Executive Board or Bargaining committee shall be eligible as a nominee and candidate for the Election Committee of the Local Union, who has been in good standing for a period of one (1) year immediately prior to the nominations. Nominations for the Election Committee shall be held at the January Membership Meeting. Candidates shall be elected for a three (3) year term.

**Did you know?**

You just got hired at Kohler Co. Your parent works at Kohler Co. and you are on their insurance. If you are staying on your parent's insurance through Kohler Co. you need to waive the insurance offered through Kohler Co. before you have completed 30 days with Kohler Co. If you don't waive the coverage, you will automatically be enrolled in the HDHP.
