You should have received information on the redesigned Kohler Choose Well...Live Well site.


Get started and log in to the Sharecare site at Sharecare.com/Kohler.

To earn \$50 per month discount off your 2024 Kohler medical premiums you need to complete two specific activities. You need to complete a RealAge Test (online) and complete a preventive exam, between January 1 and November 30, 2023. If you enroll your spouse or domestic partner in a Kohler medical plan, you can double your contribution discount if you both participate. Save up to \$600 per year if you enroll in a Kohler medical plan (up to \$1,200 per year if you have an enrolled spouse and both participate).

In addition, select well-being activities you'd like to participate in throughout the year to earn points toward Choose Well Credits. Choose Well credits for 2023, benefitseligible associates can earn up to \$300 in Choose Well credits, which are lump-sum taxable dollars applied directly to your paycheck. January 1 - April 30, 2023, earn 100 points for \$100 Choose Well credits. May 1 - August 31, 2023, earn 100 points for \$100 Choose Well credits. September 1 -November 30, 2023, earn 100 points for \$100 Choose Well credits.
