Question asked and answered

I am on short-term disability. I received a bill for my Kohler insurance premium from bswift. Is this correct?

With the conversion to bswift, Kohler's set-up for benefit premium payments while on leave of absence updated as well. In WEX, only those associates who were on Work Comp or LTD (Long-term disability) leave were directly billed for their benefit premiums. Starting in 2024 with bswift, associates who are on leave of absence for more than 30 days will transition to direct bill for their elected benefit premiums. This does include STD (short-term disability) leaves.

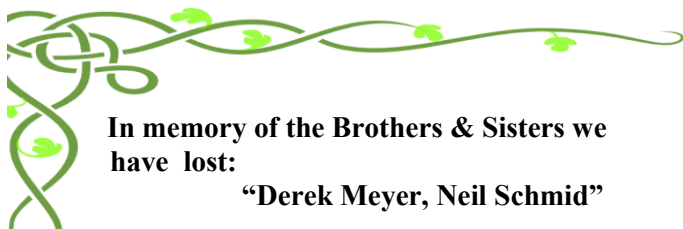
