is asking if you have heard of Ruby's Pantry? With the rising prices they thought maybe some people would like this information.

Ruby's Pantry is for ANYONE that eats! There is no income or residency requirement and Ruby's Pantry is for anyone looking to extend their monthly grocery budget. Each guest donates a \$25 donation and receives an abundance of grocery items. Ruby's Pantry is not government funded and is a 501(C)3. Each donation is used to cover operational costs like trucking, gas, and warehouse staff. All of the food is donated by corporate food donors making it possible to reach more families each month at locations across Minnesota and Wisconsin.

The next pop-up pantry in Sheboygan is Thursday, June 16, 2022 at 2313 N 31st St., Sheboygan. Registration begins at 5:30 pm; food bundles available 5:30-7:00 pm.

Short-term Disability

You have tested positive for Covid (home tests not accepted) by a facility. Now what? Contact Kohler 920-457-4441 extension 74900 option 1, option 1. This is the contact number to receive disability paperwork. They will email or mail a hard copy to you. To ensure you receive the correct paperwork you should share that you received a positive covid test (home tests not accepted). You will have to share the positive Covid test with Kohler. The CDC guidelines for Covid is you can leave isolation after five days. The first three days are unpaid, the next two days would be paid. If you are out more than five days you will have to see a doctor for disability.
